

2 Gods – 3 Persons – Please Explain
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Some who study the documents and videos have a difficult time in understanding the concept of the 2 Gods, the Father and the Son, and the Holy Spirit, the third Person of the Godhead. Many wonder how could a Person not have a physical body?

We are so used to thinking about God from a human standpoint. In other words we think that the word person must mean there must be a physical presence. Our spirit is within us and not outside of us and in that sense we create the limitation on God, hence we accept a third God being. Humanly speaking, God's prophets are an exception when they are in vision. The body is here on earth, miraculously preserved without breath through the duration of the vision, while their spirit, which is their person is in the third heaven in the presence of Jesus. Outside of that, let me show you how God made the mystery of the third Person clear to me.

Remember years ago the little jingle we would recite when someone may have said something we did not appreciate? Sticks and stones will hurt my bones, but words will never hurt me. We said that to feel better, but the fact is we were hurt in our spirit.

Let me give you an example that God gave me. Two men, one white and one black, are arguing heatedly. At one point the white man calls the black man by the "N" word. Did that word hurt the black man physically? Did it hurt his leg or arm, or maybe his back or foot? The answer of course is no. He was hurt deep down in his spirit. You see the spirit is every bit the person as is the physical body.

We are made in the image of God. That is why we possess a spirit. The Father is Holy and physically He is in the third heaven and He has a Spirit, a Holy Spirit that is capable of being wounded by the actions, thoughts and words of mankind. The begotten Son of God is Holy and He too has a Spirit called the Spirit of Christ, also identified as the Comforter and Holy Spirit. It is Their Holy Spirit that is the Omnipresent third Person of the Godhead.

The danger of course in believing the Trinity doctrine about a third God is where we fall into Satan's trap. Remember in Isaiah 14:14 when he said, "**I will be like the most High?**" It is in the Trinity doctrine that he is the third being, posing as God the Holy Spirit. He is a fraud and what is most sad is the fact that many pastors are encouraging praying to God the Holy Spirit. We need only to pray to the Father or the Son. Prayers to a third God go to Satan. Very dangerous.
